AMENDED ORDINANCE 2016 – 4256

Passed March 21, 2016

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE, AND ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR, A NEW POSITION OF EMPLOYMENT (POLICE DEPARTMENT SERGEANT) WITHIN THE CITY OF PATASKALA

WHEREAS, the general safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Pataskala is dependent upon the efficient and effective operation of City departments and staff, including the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Pataskala Police Department has determined it is necessary to create and staff an additional sergeant position. This new position will allow the Department to have a supervisory employee on every shift; and

WHEREAS, the Pataskala Police Department anticipates promoting an existing officer to fill this new sergeant position; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala now wants to create this new position and establish a starting salary so that the Police Department can fill the position.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The fourth full-time position of Police Department Sergeant is hereby created within the City of Pataskala.

Section 2: The sergeant position created in Section 1 shall be classified with a starting salary of \$53,060.80 annually.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the earliest date allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
