A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE 300 TONS OF ROAD SALT FROM BENCHMARK RIVER AND RAIL TERMINALS AND TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has a duty to treat public roadways during snow and ice events; and

WHEREAS, the City utilizes road salt as part of the snow and ice management for public roadways; and

WHEREAS, the statewide salt shortage during the current winter has resulted in the City of Pataskala searching for opportunities to purchase additional road salt; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has the opportunity to purchase three hundred (300) tons of rock salt from Benchmark River and Rail Terminals.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:


Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized to purchase three hundred (300) tons of rock salt from Benchmark River and Rail Terminals in an amount not to exceed \$41,000.

Section 2: City Council waives the competitive bidding requirement for the purchase of road salt from Benchmark River and Rail Terminals.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
