**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE 500 TONS OF ROAD SALT FROM BENCHMARK RIVER AND RAIL TERMINALS AND TO WAIVE THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS.**

*WHEREAS*, the City of Pataskala has a duty to treat public roadways during snow and ice events; and

*WHEREAS*, the City utilizes road salt as part of the snow and ice management for public roadways; and

*WHEREAS*, the statewide salt shortage during the current winter has resulted in the City of Pataskala searching for opportunities to purchase additional road salt; and

*WHEREAS*, the City of Pataskala has the opportunity to purchase five hundred (500) tons of rock salt from Benchmark River and Rail Terminals.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:**


**Section 1:** The City Administrator is hereby authorized to purchase five hundred (500) tons of rock salt from Benchmark River and Rail Terminals in an amount not to exceed \$68,000.

**Section 2:** City Council waives the competitive bidding requirement for the purchase of road salt from Benchmark River and Rail Terminals.


**Section 3:** This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
