A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH MARTIN & WOOD APPRAISAL GROUP, LTD. FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY APPRAISAL REVIEW SERVICES FOR THE TAYLOR ROAD TRAIL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala received a Transportation Alternative Funds grant from ODOT for the construction of a leisure trail on Taylor Road and a sidewalk on Cleveland Road; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires the right-of-way that will be acquired to complete this project be appraised; and

WHEREAS, the grant also requires the right-of-way appraisal be reviewed by a third party appraiser; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with Martin & Wood Appraisal Group, LTD for right-of-way appraisal review services as provided in the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the right-of-way appraisal review is \$3,500 which the City is responsible for paying 100% of this cost.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:


Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into and execute an agreement with Martin & Wood Appraisal Group, LTD. for right-of-way appraisal review services in an amount not to exceed \$3,500.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
