A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Licking County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part within the ten mill limitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1: The amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, are hereby accepted as provided within the attached "Schedule A" and "Schedule B"


Section 2: The rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of the City of Pataskala.


Section 3: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Auditor of Licking County, Ohio.

Section 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.


Section 5: This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.

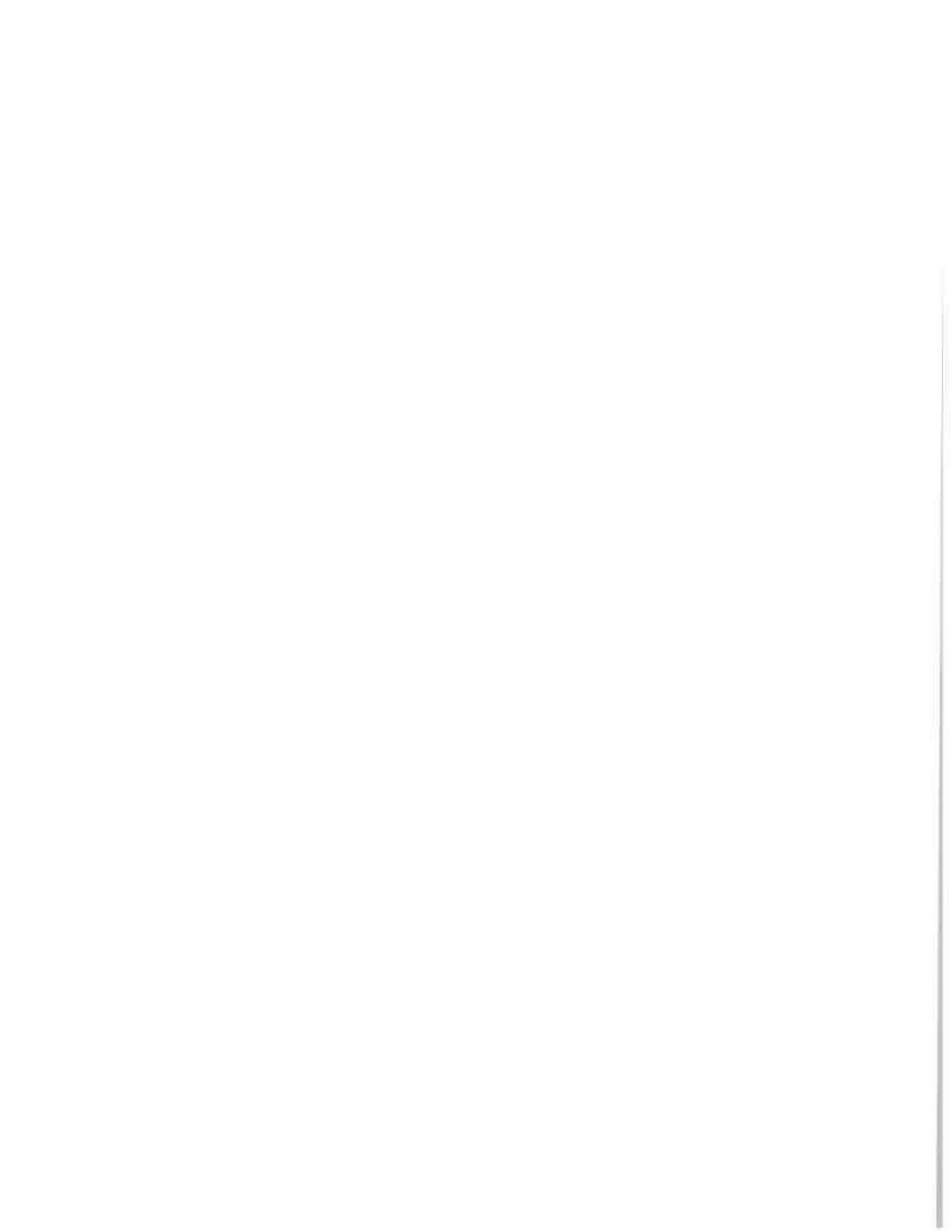

1. Introduction

The purpose of this study is to investigate the effects of various factors on the performance of a system. The study is organized as follows: Section 2 describes the methodology used in the study. Section 3 presents the results of the study. Section 4 discusses the implications of the findings. Section 5 concludes the study.

1.1

The study was conducted using a series of experiments. The first experiment was designed to measure the effect of factor A on the system's performance. The second experiment was designed to measure the effect of factor B on the system's performance. The third experiment was designed to measure the effect of factor C on the system's performance. The results of the experiments are presented in Section 3.

The findings of the study indicate that factor A has a significant positive effect on the system's performance. Factor B has a significant negative effect on the system's performance. Factor C has a significant positive effect on the system's performance. The implications of these findings are discussed in Section 4.

In conclusion, the study has shown that factor A, factor B, and factor C all have significant effects on the system's performance. The findings of the study have important implications for the design and operation of the system.
