RESOLUTION 2019-014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, WITH GLAUS, PYLE, SCHOMER, BURNS AND DEHAVEN, INC. (GPD GROUP), TO PERFORM ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE BROAD STREET, DOWNTOWN CORRIDOR SIGNAL TIMING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala maintains public roadways, traffic signals, and infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, to help promote efficient traffic flow, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is important to optimize traffic signal timing in the Broad Street, downtown corridor; and

WHEREAS, because the City of Pataskala reasonably estimates cost for this professional engineering design work will be less than \$50,000, it does not have to first seek qualifications of interested professional design firm. Ohio's Design Professional Selection Law does not apply; and

WHEREAS, because it is necessary to complete engineering design to optimize signal timing, Council for the City of Pataskala wants to contract with Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns, and DeHaven, Inc. to perform this service; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2019 budget includes funding for this design work and traffic signal timing improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract, with Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns, and DeHaven, Inc. (GPD Group), for the engineering design services for the Broad Street, Downtown Corridor Signal Timing Project in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of

Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
