RESOLUTION 2019-019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE, AND REVIEW BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF PHASES 1 AND 2 OF THE PATASKALA SAFE TRAVEL PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala maintains public roadways, bridges, and infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes that it is necessary and important to provide safe travel to pedestrians along and across public roadways within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Director, the City Administration, and Council for the City of Pataskala want to begin construction in 2019 of Phases 1 and 2 of the Pataskala Safe Travel Plan; and

WHEREAS, because the City of Pataskala reasonably estimates costs for Phases 1 and 2 of the Pataskala Safe Travel Plan will exceed \$50,000, it needs to seek competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2019 budget includes funding for this improvement project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator, or his designee, to advertise, receive, and review bids for the construction of Phases 1 and 2 of the Pataskala Safe Travel Plan, as allowed and provided under Section 8.02 of the City Charter.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
