RESOLUTION 2019-027

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH GLAUS, PYLE, SCHOMER, BURNS AND DEHAVEN, INC. TO PERFORM THE CITY OF PATASKALA INTERSECTION SAFETY AND CAPACITY STUDY

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala maintains public roadways, traffic signals, intersections, and infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is necessary and important to: understand the operation of intersections within the City; rate, rank, and prioritize intersection improvements; investigate alternatives for top priority improvements; and implement new signal timing to improve the safety and capacity of intersections throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, because the City of Pataskala reasonably estimates cost for this professional study will be less than \$50,000, it does not have to first seek qualifications of interested professional design firm. Ohio's Design Professional Selection Law does not apply; and

WHEREAS, because it is necessary to engage professional engineering services to complete the intersection safety and capacity study, Council for the City of Pataskala wants to contract with Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns, and DeHaven, Inc. to perform this service; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2019 budget includes funding for this improvement project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract with Glaus, Pyle, Schomer, Burns, and DeHaven, Inc. for professional engineering services for the City of Pataskala Intersection Safety and Capacity Study in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the

City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
