RESOLUTION 2019-036

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT THE BID OF, AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH, THE SHELLY COMPANY FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE 2019 RAMP PROGRAM

WHEREAS, as required by Section 8.02 of the Charter, the City of Pataskala advertised and received bids, via Resolution 2019-018, for the 2019 RAMP Roadway Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the bid opening for this project was held on Tuesday, April 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid for the Base Bid was submitted by The Shelly Company in the amount of \$659,793.44, which is within the awardable threshold of 10% of the engineer's estimate; and

WHEREAS, Council of the City of Pataskala hereby recognize the need to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder and believes The Shelly Company's bid meets this requirement; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Base Bid work, the City of Pataskala also wants to complete Bid Alternate #1 at this time, and make improvements to Old Maids Lane, in the amount of \$121,899.45; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Base Bid work, the City of Pataskala also wants to complete Bid Alternate #2 at this time, and reconstruct Highland Court, in the amount of \$125,220.35; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized to accept the bid of, and enter into a contract with, The Shelly Company for the 2019 RAMP Roadway Improvement Project with the total project amount not to exceed \$906,913.24 for the Base Bid, Bid Alternate #1, and Bid Alternate #2.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the

City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
