RESOLUTION 2019-042

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CORVUS JANITORIAL SYSTEMS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ROUTINE FACILITY JANITORIAL AND CLEANING SERVICES IN CITY HALL, THE POLICE STATION AND OLD TOWN HALL

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has a significant investment in municipal facilities, including City Hall, the Police Station, and Old Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain these City facilities in an appropriate condition for City employees, contractors and the general public, the buildings require routine and ongoing cleaning and janitorial services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala solicited bids through a formal Request for Proposal process to which it received two responses/proposals; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration reviewed these responses and determined it is in the City's best interest to contract with Corvus Janitorial Systems, which provided the lowest bid, to provide cleaning and janitorial services at City Hall, the Police Station, and Old Town Hall.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with Corvus Janitorial Systems, in the amount of **Three Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and No Cents (\$3,975.00) per month** for the period beginning on June 17, 2019 and ending on June 16, 2021.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
