RESOLUTION 2019-043

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SPENCO EXCAVATING, INC. FOR THE EMERGENCY STATE ROUTE 310 CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, due to age and the recent heavy rainfall, a culvert on State Route 310 was unexpectedly and severely damaged; and

WHEREAS, the damaged culvert created an immediate unsafe driving situation along State Route 310; and

WHEREAS, because the City Administration needed to proceed with an emergency repair of the culvert, Spenco Excavating, Inc. was hired, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000, to make the repairs; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration now requests Council for the City of Pataskala retroactive approve and ratify the emergency State Route 310 culvert repair and the contract with Spenco Excavating, Inc. to perform this work.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby retroactively approves and ratifies the emergency State Route 310 culvert repair. In doing so, Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to enter into a contract with Spenco Excavating, Inc. to complete the emergency Taylor Road Culvert Replacement Project in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the

City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
