A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL WASH AUTHORITY, LLC FOR THE CLEANING AND TOUCH UP PAINT SERVICES OF MULTIPLE WATER TANKS

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Utility Department provides drinking water to customers via a treatment and distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the treatment and distribution systems use multiple water tanks for both treatment and storage purposes; and

WHEREAS, these tanks require routine cleaning and touch up paint work to maintain their pleasing appearance and structural integrity; and

WHEREAS, National Wash Authority, LLC provided a labor and materials quote to (1) wash the Iron Filter and both Clearwell Tanks at Water Treatment Plant 2 and (2) wash and paint (touch up only) the Southeast Water Tower, in an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$30,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the necessary funds are available for this work under the 2019 Utility Budget; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is in the City's best interest to fund this project at this time and hire National Wash Authority, LLC to perform this work.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract in an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$30,000.00), with National Wash Authority, LLC for the labor and materials to (1) wash the Iron Filter and both Clearwell Tanks at Water Treatment Plant 2 and (2) wash and paint (touch up only) the Southeast Water Tower.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of

Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
