RESOLUTION 2019-068

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH SPENCO EXCAVATING, INC. FOR INSTALLATION OF AN OUTLET STRUCTURE ON THE GLENBROOKE SUBDIVISION RETENTION POND

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala maintains certain roadways and stormwater infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, Monarch Drive has flooded because of inadequate outlet controls on the existing retention pond within the Glenbrooke Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it to be necessary to install an outlet structure on the retention pond in the Glenbrooke Subdivision to help prevent flooding on Monarch Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala received three bids from qualified contractors, and SpenCo Excavating, Inc. submitted the lowest and best bid in the amount of \$15,650.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for the project is available within the existing 2019 City of Pataskala Public Service Department budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract, in an amount not to exceed \$15,650.00, with SpenCo Excavating, Inc. to install an outlet structure on the Glenbrooke Retention Pond.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in

compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
