ORDINANCE 2019-4357

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF PATASKALA SCHEDULE OF MUNICIPAL FEES AND THEREBY ADD SECTION D (PARKS AND RECREATION)

WHEREAS, with Ordinance 2017-4303, adopted on January 16, 2018, Council for the City of Pataskala established a Schedule of Municipal Fees; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 Municipal Fee Schedule contained only a general Park Use Fee, as it relates to new construction. The City Administration recommends adding a more detailed Parks and Recreation Fee Schedule that reflects and encompasses the growing use of the City's park spaces; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala now wants to accept the Administration's recommendation and amend the City of Pataskala Municipal Fee Schedule by adding Section D (Parks and Recreation).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby amends and adopts the City of Pataskala Municipal Fee Schedule, as set forth in the fee schedule attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with legislation is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
