RESOLUTION 2020-001

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO RE-ADVERTISE, RECEIVE, AND REVIEW BIDS FOR THE LIBERTY PARK NATUREWORKS GRANT FUNDED IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala owns and is responsible for the maintenance and improvement of public parks; and

WHEREAS, the City submitted for, and was awarded, a NatureWorks Grant in the amount of \$68,579 for development and improvement to Liberty Park; and

WHEREAS, earlier this year, the City of Pataskala requested bids for the Liberty Park Improvement Project. Two bids were received (from Robertson Construction and Midstates Recreation). However, because both company's bids contained calculation errors and Midstates Recreation's bid was ten percent over the engineering estimate, Hull & Associates, Inc. recommended the City not accept either bid; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala remains committed to the Liberty Park Improvement Project. As such, it is necessary to re-advertise and receive bids for the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to re-advertise, receive, and review bids for the construction of the NatureWorks Grant-funded Liberty Park improvement.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
