RESOLUTION 2020-010

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH LEBANON FORD TO PURCHASE A NEW FULLY-EQUIPPED 2020 FORD INTERCEPTOR SUV (CRUISER #1)

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has a continuing duty to the public to provide efficient and effective service delivery to the residents of, and visitors to, the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has determined it necessary to add a police vehicle to its current fleet. As such, the City of Pataskala Division of Police wants to purchase a 2020 Ford Interceptor SUV (Cruiser #1); and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala found this vehicle, via the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program, at Lebanon Ford; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala budgeted for the purchase of this cruiser as part of its 2020 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract, via the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program, with Lebanon Ford, to purchase a new fully-equipped 2020 Ford Interceptor SUV Police Cruiser, at an amount not to exceed Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$48,000.00).

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the

City of Pataskala.
