- **Active Living Everyday Program**

  - **Liberty Park:** Currently the project is on a halt. We are appealing to the state for a variance to add structure/shelter to the site without adding bathroom facilities on site.
  - **Karr Park Nature Works:** We anticipate placing the project out to BID in October and bring to council for awarding contract on November 2<sup>nd</sup>

  - Passport to Fishing Program: September and October:
