



## CITY OF PATASKALA

### COUNCIL MEETING

July 19, 2021

The Council of the City of Pataskala met in regular session on July 19, 2021, at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers, located at 621 W. Broad Street. The pledge of allegiance was given. Roll Call: Walther, Epperson, Barstow, Hampshire, and Galik-present. Carter and Lee were absent. Mayor Michael W. Compton presiding and Brian Zets, Law Director were present.

#### **Citizens Comments**

There were none.

#### **Discussion and approval of Consent Agenda matters**

Walther asked that Resolution 2021-035 be removed from the Consent Agenda and be placed on the Regular Agenda under item 8(B).

Walther made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Seconded by Galik. Roll Call: Walther, Epperson, Barstow, Hampshire, and Galik-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

The Consent Agenda included the Administrator's Report, Department Reports, approval of the July 6, 2021 Council Meeting Minutes.

#### **Reports**

Mayor Compton gave an update on the upcoming Parade of Champions.

Tim Hickin, City Administrator requested Resolution 2021-035 be tabled. He accepted questions from Council.

Jamie Nicholson, Finance Director noted a supplemental appropriation will need to be passed once Resolution 2021-035 is adopted. Mr. Nicholson accepted questions from Council.

Chris Sharrock, Utility Director gave an update on department activities. Mr. Sharrock accepted questions from Council.

Alan Haines, Director of Public Services addressed current projects and department activities. Mr. Haines accepted questions from Council. Mayor Compton thanked the Street Department for their efforts.

Scott Fulton, Planning Director, addressed the current staffing in his department. Mr. Fulton gave an update on the status of the car lot on Taylor Rd. Mr. Fulton accepted questions from Council.

On behalf of Lenier Crawford, Park Manager, Mr. Hickin reviewed various projects and department activities. He accepted questions from Council.

Chief Brooks had nothing to report but accepted questions from Council.

### **Unfinished Business**

Walther made a motion to have the third reading of Ordinance 2021-4397. Seconded by Epperson. The Clerk read the following:

**ORDINANCE 2021-4397** Third Reading An ordinance levying special assessments for sidewalk improvements upon adjacent lots located on the east side of Oak Meadow Drive.

Barstow made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2021-4397. Seconded by Walther. Roll Call: Epperson, Barstow, Hampshire, Galik, and Walther-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

Walther made a motion to have the third reading of Ordinance 2021-4399. Seconded by Epperson. The Clerk read the following:

**ORDINANCE 2021-4399** Third Reading An ordinance to create, and establish compensation for, a new full-time position of employment (Police Clerk) within the City of Pataskala, and to amend the 2020-2022 Pay Matrix for the Non-Collectively Bargained Employees for the City of Pataskala, effective for the pay period beginning on and after July 25, 2021.

Walther made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2021-4399. Seconded by Galik. Roll Call: Hampshire, Galik, Walther, Epperson, and Barstow-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

### **New Business**

Galik made a motion to have the first reading of Ordinance 2021-4396. Seconded by Walther. The Clerk read the following:

**ORDINANCE 2021-4396** First Reading An ordinance creating, establishing, and adopting Chapter 1294 (Impact Fees) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Pataskala.

Walther made a motion to table **RESOLUTION 2021-035** A resolution authorizing and directing the City Administrator to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Etna Township, Licking County, and the Licking County Transportation Improvement District. Seconded by Epperson. Roll Call: Walther, Epperson, Barstow, Hampshire, and Galik-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

Walther made a motion to authorize the use of the message boards for the Parade of Champions. Seconded by Epperson. Roll Call: Epperson, Barstow, Hampshire, Galik, and Walther-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

**Additional Citizens' Comments**

There were no comments.

**Committee Meeting Announcements, Scheduling Issues & General Comments**

Epperson thanked Scott Fulton and Alan Haines for all the work on the Impact Fees.

Galik echoed Mr. Epperson's comments and included Mr. Zets and noted it was nice everyone working together.

Hampshire thanked the Street Department for taking care of Havens Corner Road.

Barstow was thankful that areas of the city are getting cleaned up. He also noted that there is bound to be a lot of questions on the proposed Impact Fees before passage.

Barstow made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Walther. Roll Call: Walther, Epperson, Barstow, Hampshire, and Galik-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.
