RESOLUTION 2021-046

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE REFUGEE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is necessary to make improvements to the Refugee Road Corridor, to wit: improve the intersection of Refugee Road and Etna Parkway; improve the intersection of Refugee Road and Mink Street; and widen the roadway, including drainage improvements, between these two intersections (“Refugee Road Improvement Project”). The City is eligible to apply for SCIP financial assistance to help fund this much needed roadway improvement work; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala would like the City Administrator to work with the City’s Engineer to complete and submit the OPWC/SCIP financial assistance application for the Refugee Road Improvements project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and submit an application, and any other necessary and related documents, to OPWC/SCIP for financial assistance for the Refugee Road Improvement Project.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
