A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE A 2022 CHEVROLET SILVERADO 3500HD, 4WD, REGULAR CAB, DUMP BED TRUCK FROM COUGHLIN AUTOMOTIVE LLC. HONORING THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROCUREMENT PROGRAM PRICE

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Utility Department is responsible for multiple infrastructure locations throughout the city; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Department maintains a fleet of vehicles that are necessary to operate and maintain city infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Department has determined that a new truck must be purchased to replace an existing truck from 1998 that has exceeded its useful lifespan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala could purchase 2022 Chevrolet Silverado, without competitive bid, through the State of Ohio Procurement Program. However, Coughlin Automotive LLC. agreed to match the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Procurement Program price for a 2022 Chevrolet Silverado 3500HD, 4WD, Regular Cab, Dump Bed Truck in an amount of Fifty-One Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and No Cents (\$51,826.00); and

WHEREAS, the necessary funds are available for this purchase under the 2022 Utility Department Budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract in the amount of Fifty-One Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and No Cents (**\$51,826.00**) with Coughlin Automotive LLC. for the purchase of a 2022 Chevrolet Silverado 3500HD, 4WD, Regular Cab, Dump Bed Truck.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.


