A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH PREFERRED COMMUNICATIONS TO PURCHASE FIVE (5) NEW MOBILE DATA COMPUTERS WITH DOCKING STATIONS FOR USE BY THE DIVISION OF POLICE

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has a continuing duty to provide efficient and effective service to the residents and businesses of the City as well as the traveling public that passes through the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police needs to replace older mobile data computers to maintain them in good working order; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police wants the City to purchase new mobile data computers and docking stations, from Preferred Communications, for not more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$15,000); and

WHEREAS, the cost of the purchase was included in the 2023 Capital Improvements Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute an agreement, consistent with Quote #2722, with Preferred Communications, for the purchase of five (5) mobile data computers and docking stations for a cost not to exceed Fifteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$15,000.00).

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
