RESOLUTION 2023-031

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A PROGRAM YEAR 2023 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT AND PRESERVATION (CHIP) PROGRAM PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LICKING COUNTY

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2019, the Licking County Board of Commissioners adopted a Policy & Procedures Manual (PPM) for all Licking County housing programs funded in whole or in part with Community Housing Improvement Program (now Community Housing Impact and Preservation) funds; and

WHEREAS, Licking County has entered into a Programmatic Agreement (PA) with the State of Ohio Historic Preservation Office (OHPO), effective until December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Licking County's PPM and PA are amended and updated on an ongoing and as needed basis in order to be in compliance with ODSA/OCD and OHPO, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala is to be a partner with Licking County in regard to applying for Program Year 2023 Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) funds from the Ohio Development Services Agency/Office of Community Development to continue housing rehabilitation activities throughout Licking County, excluding the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Development Services Agency/Office of Community Development requires Licking County and the City of Pataskala adopt one PPM and one PA for the partnership for the duration of the PY 2023 CHIP grant period.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement, in substantially the same form and content as the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, with the Board of Commissioners of Licking County.

Section 2: The City of Pataskala, as a partnering jurisdiction, hereby adopts Licking County's Programmatic Agreement with OHPO and Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Policy and Procedures Manual, as amended, including, but not limited to Client Selection, Income Eligibility Method and Finance Mechanism for the administration and implementation of eligible housing activities to be performed throughout Licking County including within the city limits of Heath with Program Year 2023 CHIP funds and leveraged funds (if funded) and Licking County CHIP housing program income funds for the duration of the PY 2023 CHIP grant period.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
