ORDINANCE 2024-4462

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING AN ADDITIONAL POSITION OF EMPLOYMENT (FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER) WITHIN THE CITY OF PATASKALA DIVISION OF POLICE

WHEREAS, the general safety and welfare of the Pataskala residents and businesses is dependent upon the efficient and effective operation of City departments and staff; and

WHEREAS, after carefully reviewing and evaluating the Police Department, it has been determined the creation of an additional full-time Police Officer position would benefit the City's Police Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby creates and establishes an additional position of employment, a full-time police officer, within the City of Pataskala Division of Police. With the addition of this position, the City of Pataskala Division of Police will have twenty-four full-time police officer positions.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
