RESOLUTION 2024-061

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A SERVICE CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF COLUMBUS FOR SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL SERVICES AND SUPPLIES

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala routinely maintains public roadways during winter storm events; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala uses brine to pre-treat roadways prior to some winter storm events; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus requested assistance with plowing the two lane-mile section of Broad Street within Franklin County which is located between the Limited Facility and the City Boundary (“Area of Responsibility”) during winter storm events; and

WHEREAS, in exchange and consideration of the City of Pataskala’s snow plowing services in the Area of Responsibility, the City of Columbus will provide 18,000 gallons of brine to the City of Pataskala as well as three (3) used brine tanks for the City of Pataskala’s use; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala reasonably estimates the value of the brine and brine tanks to be roughly equal to the value of plowing snow in the Area of Responsibility; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala wants to take advantage of the City of Columbus’s offer and enter into a mutually beneficial snow and ice removal services trade agreement with the City of Columbus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a service contract, for the time period of October 31, 2024 to April 15, 2028, with the City of Columbus for snow and ice removal services and supplies.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that

all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
