A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH HEADWAY STRATEGY, LLC. FOR INFORMATION AND TECHNOLOGY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Administration utilizes numerous information and technology (IT) systems as a part of its daily operations; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala recognizes the need to hire an IT services consultant to manage and secure those systems; and

WHEREAS, because the Administration reasonably estimated cost of this contract could exceed \$75,000.00 and it wanted to solicit proposals from different vendors, the Administration followed the RFP process to accept and review proposals from interested IT service providers; and

WHEREAS, following the RFP process, the Administration believes that Headway Strategy, LLC. provided the lowest and best proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract, in substantially the same form and content as the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, with Headway Strategy, LLC. to provide IT services for the City of Pataskala.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
