A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT C.S. ELECTRIC AND EXCAVATING LLC TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL A PERMANENT STANDBY GENERATOR AND AUTOMATIC TRANSFER SWITCH FOR THE SUGAR MILL LIFT STATION

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Utility Department is responsible for multiple lift stations that require a backup power supply; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Department determined a permanent standby generator at sugar mill lift station is a critical addition for our collection system readiness; and

WHEREAS, C.S. Electric and Excavating LLC provided a quote, in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents, for the purchase and installation of a 35kW backup generator set and automatic transfer switch at the Sugar Mill Lift Station; and

WHEREAS, the funds to pay for this project are within the 2024 Utility Department Budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract, with C.S. Electric and Excavating LLC for the purchase and installation of a 35kW backup generator and automatic transfer switch at the Sugar Mill Lift Station, in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
